EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND

Dr. Jabbour earned both a Bachelor of Science in Physiology as well as a Doctor of Medicine and Master of Surgery with great distinction from McGill University in Montreal, Quebec. He then went on to complete a residency in ophthalmology at the University of Montreal where he served as chief resident.

Dr. Jabbour also completed two years of fellowship in cornea, anterior segment, and refractive surgery where he trained with world leaders in the field at the prestigious Wilmer Eye Institute, Johns Hopkins School of Medicine in Baltimore, USA and at the world renown Moorfields Eye Hospital NHS Foundation Trust in London, United Kingdom (UK). He is double board certified in Ophthalmology in both Canada and the USA.

REFRACTIVE EXPERIENCE

Dr. Jabbour has extensive experience in a variety of ocular procedures, including LASIK eye surgery, PRK surgery, Corneal Cross-Linking (CXL) as well as cataract and corneal surgeries. He's currently an Ophthalmologist as well as a Cornea, Cataract, and External Disease Specialist at the Centre hospitalier de l'Université de Montréal (CHUM).

In addition, Dr. Jabbour is an Assistant Professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Montreal where he supervises and teaches medical students and ophthalmology residents. He is also the director of the Cornea fellowship at the CHUM.



ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND AWARDS

Dr. Jabbour's research has been published in a number of prestigious scientific journals, including *Ophthalmology*, *the Journal of the American medical Association (JAMA)*, *the Journal of Refractive Surgery*, *Cornea*, *the Canadian Journal of Ophthalmology* amongst many others. He has won several research grants and has participated in clinical trials in Canada, the USA and the United Kingdom.

As one of the leading researchers in ophthalmology, Dr. Jabbour has lent his expertise as an external reviewer for various renowned journals, such as *Cornea*, *Clinical Ophthalmology*, and *BMC Ophthalmology*.

Similarly, Dr. Jabbour has presented his work at a number of conferences, including at the annual meetings for the Canadian Ophthalmology Society (COS), the American Academy of Ophthalmology (AAO), and the Association for Research in Vision and Ophthalmology (ARVO). He served as organizing member of several national and international meetings including the Cornea Focus meeting committee held in London, and the EOUM of the University of Montreal.

Dr. Jabbour has also won several awards during his training based on academic achievement.
